Jonah – People Change But God Does Not Scripture

- **Jon 1:3a** But Jonah arose to flee to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord.

- **Jon 3:7b 8** Let neither man nor beast, herd nor flock, taste anything; do not let them eat, or drink water. 8 But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily to God; yes, let every one turn from his evil way and from the violence that is in his hands.
